## Writing about THE TEST (This is a grade!)

I will not look at these until the 48 hour "waiting period" has ended so you can reveal information about the essays that we cannot discuss until 48 hours have passed.

## Items to consider in your discussion.

- What book did you use for the $3^{\text {rd }}$ question? Why did you choose that book? How well do you think you answered the prompt and discussed the elements requested?
- Discuss what you wrote on the $1^{\text {st }}$ question. Did you address the prompt completely?
- Discuss what you wrote on the $2^{\text {nd }}$ question. Again, did you address the prompt completely?
- What problems did you encounter on any of the questions?
- What activities, discussions, readings, etc. do you think helped you the most this year? Why do you think they helped?
- What new activities, discussions, readings, etc. do you think could be added for the students next year? Why do you think they would help the students?
- What test taking strategies appeared to help you the most, especially on the multiple choice selections?
- How prepared did you feel for the different sections of the test? Is there a section where you think additional preparation would have helped? What additional preparation do you suggest?
- Feel free to discuss anything else about the test and preparation for the test that you this is pertinent and important.
