Mental Tug Of War

- 1. Have the class individually answer the questions from the anticipation guide. Stress that they must choose either yes or no.
- 2. Divide the room into two sides; one side will represent "yes" and the other side will represent "no".
- 3. Flash each question from the guide onto the screen. Students should walk to the side of the room that they agree with.
- 4. Students will have three to five minutes to discuss with their group why they chose their side. Then, they will choose a representative to speak for the group.
- 5. Each group's representative will debate their point of view. This process may last as long as you want.
- 6. Move on to the next question and repeat the steps.
- 7. At the end of the activity, you may wish to have students complete a short answer response based on one of the questions presented.

*Note: This activity can easily be replicated for any work and any level.
