Synthesis Essay

REHUGO - Part I

Integrate and document at least three (3) of your sources in a coherent, well written essay. Refer to your sources to support your position; avoid mere paraphrase or summary. Your argument should be central; the sources should support this argument. Remember to attribute both direct and indirect citations.

Synthesis—n. the combining of often varied and diverse ideas, forces, or factors into one coherent and consistent complex; the combination of separate elements of sensation or thought into a whole; the putting together of parts or elements so as to form a whole.



Using the sources you have gathered for your REHUGO assignment, address one of the following in a synthesis essay.

- a. What changes in society would you make to address your universal truth and/or solve the issues you discovered in your REHUGO research?
- b. Can you propose a new or alternative approach to solve the issues you found in your REHUGO research? How does your universal truth fit with your approach?
- c. In what way would you combine ideas from your issues and universal truth you discovered in your REHUGO research to improve (change) the current situation?
- d. Develop a position about what issues should be considered most important in making decisions about the central topic you discovered in your REHUGO research.
- e. Develop a position on whether or not factors in the issues and universal truth you discovered in your REHUGO research should be eliminated. Make sure you support why they should or should not be eliminated.
