

Literary Scrabble

In your groups, each student will create words which must relate to "An Enemy of the People". You may certainly use any literary terms that appear in the play. Each word you place on the Scrabble board must have a literary connection with "An Enemy of the People".

Each player may begin with nine tiles. Each time you create a word, you replenish you tiles. If you use four, you take four. Add up the total for each word.

You have two charts. On the first one, cite specific images and/or phrases from the actual poem. Then, briefly explain using other words associated with that image and/or synonyms how those images relate to the larger thematic idea. In the second chart, record the words you play during your match of Scrabble and explain how that word could relate to the larger thematic concept you perceive in the poem. Make good use of the tone words you have discovered so far.

Image/phrase from the poem	Words/concepts/abstract ideas you associate with the image

Scrabble word played	How the Scrabble word relates to the poem (theme/bigger picture)

What is the thematic message this poem presents? Write a clear thesis/claim explaining that.
